In consideration of the Stanford University Archaeology Collections of the Stanford Archaeology Center (SUAC) allowing me to examine and/or make a physical and/or digital copies (“reproductions”) of items from its archival collections, I hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

I agree that that the reproductions are solely for my own personal use. No such reproductions used or made by me will be publicly exhibited in any manner or medium, or further reproduced or disseminated, except for the following legitimate research and educational purposes for which SUAC grants permission:

- Non-commercial lecturing, as in teaching or at professional meetings.
- Unpublished documents such as funding proposals or reports to sponsoring agencies.
- Course research papers, theses, presentations, and dissertations.
- Circulation of pre-publication research materials to colleagues.
- Computerized database for my own use.
- All uses must include the museum/document reference number and the credit line "Courtesy of the Stanford University Archaeology Collections of the Stanford Archaeology Center."

I understand and agree that any other use of these reproductions will require the prior written permission of SUAC and shall be governed by the policies of SUAC and Stanford University.

- I agree to provide SUAC copies of reproductions free of charge upon request at any date.
- I understand that if I do not agree to restrict my use of the reproductions as set forth in this agreement, SUAC will not allow me to examine and/or reproduce from its collection.
- I agree that if I breach the provisions of this Permission, I may be required to pay Stanford University a sum to be determined by Stanford as liquidated damages.
- In addition, I agree that Stanford University may specifically enforce in any court of competent jurisdiction the obligations set forth in this Permission. The remedies of liquidated damages and injunctive relief shall be in addition to all other remedies available at law or in equity.

I agree to the following terms:

- The original documents remain the property of SUAC.
- To acknowledge that items represent historical perspectives and may include offensive, outdated, and/or incorrect information that does not represent current views of SUAC and Stanford University.
- No reproductions shall be disseminated to any other individual, institution, or agency.
- To regard the following as confidential: financial and gift information (including values); contact information of private individuals or donors; archaeological site locations.
- To honor all requests by donors, prospects, and volunteers for anonymity and/or confidentiality.
- To treat all confidential or potentially sensitive information to ensure that it is not disclosed, whether in the course of business dealings or in family and social situations.
- Not to share confidential information with other students or Stanford Employees not employed by the Stanford University Archaeology Collection or the Cantor Arts Center, parents, friends, the media, the general public, or any other person, group, or organization.
